

Four A's Protocol

1. The group views the video silently, writing notes in answer to the following four questions:
 - What Assumptions do the speakers hold?
 - What do you Agree with in the video?
 - What do you want to Argue with in the video?
 - What might you Aspire to after viewing the video?
2. In a round, have each person identify one Assumption in the video, citing a section as evidence.
3. Either continue in rounds, or facilitate a conversation, in which the group discusses the video in light of each of the remaining A's, taking them one at a time.
4. End the session with an open discussion framed around a question such as: What does this mean for our work with students?
5. Debrief the protocol experience.
